**NOTICE OF CLARIFICATION AND
CORRECTION REGARDING
RENEWED MOTION TO DISQUALIFY
JUDGE**

COMES NOW the Defendant, Diego Rodriguez, pro se, and respectfully submits this *Notice to Clarify and Correct* a reference made in the *Renewed Motion to Disqualify Judge Nancy A. Baskin* filed on May 23, 2025.

In the motion, Defendant quoted a prior version of Idaho Rule of Civil Procedure 40(d)(1) as stating:

"The motion and affidavit must be presented to the presiding judge, who must either grant or deny the motion within 14 days without hearing."

Upon further review, it has come to the Defendant's attention that this sentence does not appear in the official version of I.R.C.P. 40(d) published by the Idaho Supreme Court and made available to the public.

While earlier practitioner materials or informal commentary may have summarized a 14-day expectation, the official version of the rule states:

“Upon the filing of a motion for disqualification, the presiding judge must not act further in the action except to grant or deny the motion for disqualification.”

Defendant acknowledges the error and submits this clarification in good faith. This correction does not alter the underlying legal and factual basis of the motion, which rests on:

- The presiding judge's failure to timely rule on a motion to disqualify implicating her own alleged misconduct;
- Her issuance of adverse rulings before addressing the disqualification motion;
- And the appearance of impropriety created by her continuing involvement in a case where her impartiality has been reasonably questioned.
