**NOTICE OF PRESERVED EVIDENCE
OF JUDICIAL MISCONDUCT AND
BIAS**

COMES NOW, Defendant Diego Rodriguez, *pro se*, and respectfully submits this Notice for the record to preserve critical evidence of judicial misconduct, ongoing bias, and procedural irregularities by the presiding judge, **Nancy A. Baskin**. This Notice is filed solely for the purpose of preserving the evidentiary record in support of pending and future motions, including potential relief under **I.R.C.P. 60(d)(3)** and/or federal constitutional review.

I. PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

- On **May 23, 2025**, Defendant filed *a Renewed Motion to Disqualify Judge Nancy Baskin*, following more than a year of unresolved and improperly handled judicial disqualification efforts.
- On **June 15, 2025**, Defendant filed a *Motion for Reconsideration of Order Denying Motion to Declare June 9 Order and All Prior Proceedings Void ab Initio*, raising jurisdictional defects due to the court's violation of **I.R.C.P. 40(d)** and **I.R.C.P. 2.3(b)**.
- On **July 1, 2025**, Defendant filed a *Request for Decision Without Oral Argument and for Immediate Reassignment to a Neutral Judge*, as required by 4th Dist. Local Rule 5.3, and requested reassignment pursuant to **I.R.C.P. 40(d)** and **Idaho Code § 1-907(a)**.

II. JUDICIAL MISCONDUCT AND PROCEDURAL VIOLATIONS

To date—as of July 8, 2025—Judge Nancy Baskin has taken no action to:

- Refer the case for reassignment as required by I.R.C.P. 40(d);
- Acknowledge the jurisdictional bar prohibiting her from further action;
- Rule on or refer the disqualification motion pending since May 2025;
- Address the uncontested Motion for Reconsideration; or
- Respond to Defendant's Rule 5.3-compliant request for decision on the papers.

This persistent inaction, combined with the prior refusal to reduce oral denials to written orders or provide proper service under I.R.C.P. 2.3(b), constitutes a sustained pattern of bias, judicial evasion, and willful violation of jurisdictional and procedural safeguards.

III. PURPOSE OF FILING

This Notice is submitted not as a motion, but **solely to preserve the factual and legal record**. It is intended to:

- Document the continuing judicial misconduct and obstruction;
- Support future Rule 60(d)(3) motions based on fraud on the court;
- Support possible federal due process and constitutional review;

- Alert any reviewing court to the procedural irregularities and unresolved disqualification violations that render all further orders by Judge Baskin void.
